A new method of checking children into the nursery, preschool Sunday school and extended care will begin on November 27, 2016.

At First Presbyterian, we believe that children are a special gift from God, and it is a privilege to care for and love your child. Therefore, we seek to offer a safe, healthy and nurturing environment for your child.

Beginning this Sunday, November 27, when you take your child to the nursery (0-2 years old) or preschool (3 and 4 year olds) Sunday School, please fill out our new sticker forms. The sticker has a place for your name, location (Sunday School class, worship, etc.), your cell

phone and places to check or note the needs of your child. You are asked to place the larger sticker on the back of your



child and the smaller one is for you. The person with the smaller sticker will be the one to whom the child is dismissed. You will need to fill out a sticker every Sunday.


